### Important safety information

#### General

- 1. Make sure the area in which the Carrier is assembled is clean and well lit. Cluttered or dark areas invite accidents.
- 2. Keep children and bystanders away while assembling the Carrier
- 3. Stay alert, watch what you are doing and use common sense when using the Carrier. Do not use the Carrier while you are tired or under the influence of drugs, alcohol or medication. A moment of inattention while using the Carrier may result in serious personal injury.

#### 4. DO NOT USE ON A TOWED VEHICLE.

#### Carrier use and care

- 1. Use the correct Carrier for your application. The correct Carrier will do the job better and safer at the rate for which it was designed.
- 2. Store the Carrier out of reach of children and do not allow people unfamiliar with the Carrier or these instructions to use the Carrier. Use of carrier by untrained people may not be safe.
- 3. Maintain the Carrier. Check for misalignment or binding of moving parts, breakage of parts and any other condition that may affect the Carrier's operation. If damaged, have the Carrier repaired before use. Many accidents are caused by poorly maintained equipment.
- 4. Use this Carrier in accordance with these instructions and in the manner intended for this particular type of product, taking into account the area conditions and the task to be performed. Use of this Carrier for operations different from those intended could result in a hazardous situation.

### Specific Safety Rules WARNING!

- 1. Follow these guidelines for installation and use.
- 2. Do not exceed 500 lb. capacity or capacity of hitch, evenly distributed. Be aware of dynamic loading! Sudden load movement may briefly create excess load causing product failure.
- 3. Install sufficiently far away from hot exhaust to prevent heat damage to carrier or cargo. Secure load before moving.
- 4. Turn vehicle's ignition OFF, set parking brake, and chock wheels before installing, loading, or unloading.
- 5. Use only as intended.
- 6. Inspect before use; do not use if parts are loose or damaged.
- 7. Wear approved safety goggles and heavy-duty work gloves during installation, loading, and unloading.
- 8. Secure load before moving. Tie down any loose cargo.
- 9. Read manual before installation and/or use. Maintain labels and name plates on the Carrier. These carry important safety information. If unreadable or missing, contact Heininger Holdings for a replacement.
- 10. Always secure the Carrier as close to your vehicle as possible, minimizing the distance of the Carrier and its load from your vehicle.
- 11. Keep Carrier clean and dry. Wash the Carrier often.
- 12. Load heaviest items toward the center of the Carrier. Be aware of openings and use larger containers that will not fall through gaps in the Carrier's framework.
- 13. Only use Carrier with a properly installed Class III or Class IV 2 inch hitch receiver capable of supporting the Carrier and its load.
- 14. The warnings, cautions, and instructions discussed in this instruction manual cannot cover all possible conditions and situations that may occur. It must be understood by the operator that common sense and caution are factors which cannot be built into this product, but must be supplied by the operator.


### Assembly

**Note:** Only finger tighten bolts until Carrier is fully assembled. Then tighten with a wrench.

- 1. Align the mounting holes on the ends of the **Right Frame (2)** and **Left Frame (3)** with the mounting holes along the sides of the **Post (1)**.
- 2. Fasten the Frames to the Post using the Bolts (10), Washers (11), and Nuts (12).
- 3. Set the Cross Braces (6) over the Frames (2, 3) and fasten the Cross Braces to the Frames using the Bolts (7), Washers (8), and Lock Nuts (9).

4. Use a wrench (not included) to tighten all bolts securely.

#### Limited Liability, Two-Year Warranty Policy

Heininger Holdings, LLC, warrants the original owner of each new HitchMate against defects in workmanship and materials for two years from the date of purchase (at retail) of the product, provided it is purchased from an authorized HitchMate dealer. This Limited Two Year Warranty is not transferable and shall only apply to normal and ordinary use, for which the product was intended.

Warranty claims are to be made directly to Heininger Holdings and must be accompanied by a sales receipt or other appropriate proof-of-purchase document. Should this product or any part or accessory be determined by Heininger Holdings, to be defective and covered by this Limited Two Year Warranty, it will be repaired or replaced at the option of Heininger Holdings, without further charge. The cost of transportation to and from the Heininger warranty inspection facility for repair or replacement of any defective part and/or accessory and any related charges is not covered by this warranty, and is to be paid by the owner.

The warranty does not cover normal wear and tear, worn and normal use cosmetic blemishes, improper assembly, lack of maintenance, or custom alteration/installation of any parts or accessories not originally intended or compatible with the product as sold. The warranty does not apply to damage or failure resulting from an accident, abuse or neglect.

This warranty is given in lieu of all other expressed warranties, implied warranties, including without limitation implied warranties of merchandising ability and fitness for a particular purpose, and are limited to the duration and specification of this warranty. In no event shall Heininger Holdings, be liable for damages in excess of the purchase price of the HitchMate, for any loss of use, loss of time, inconvenience, commercial loss, lost profits or savings or any incidental, special, consequential, direct or indirect damages arising out of the use or inability to use such product, to the full extent as such may be disclaimed by the law. Labor charges for part changeover are not covered by this warranty.
